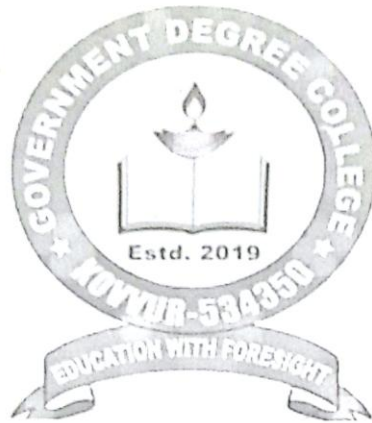

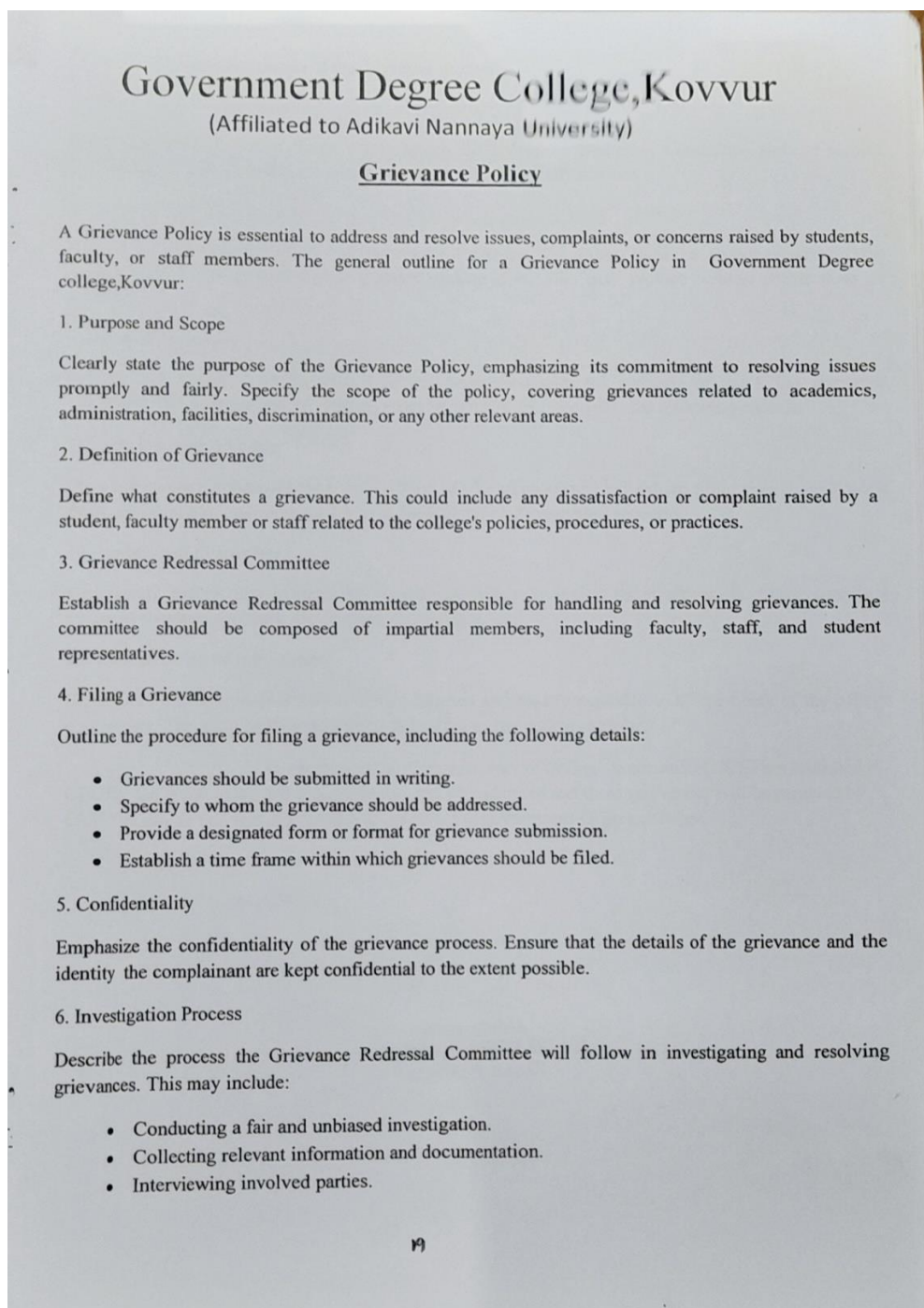

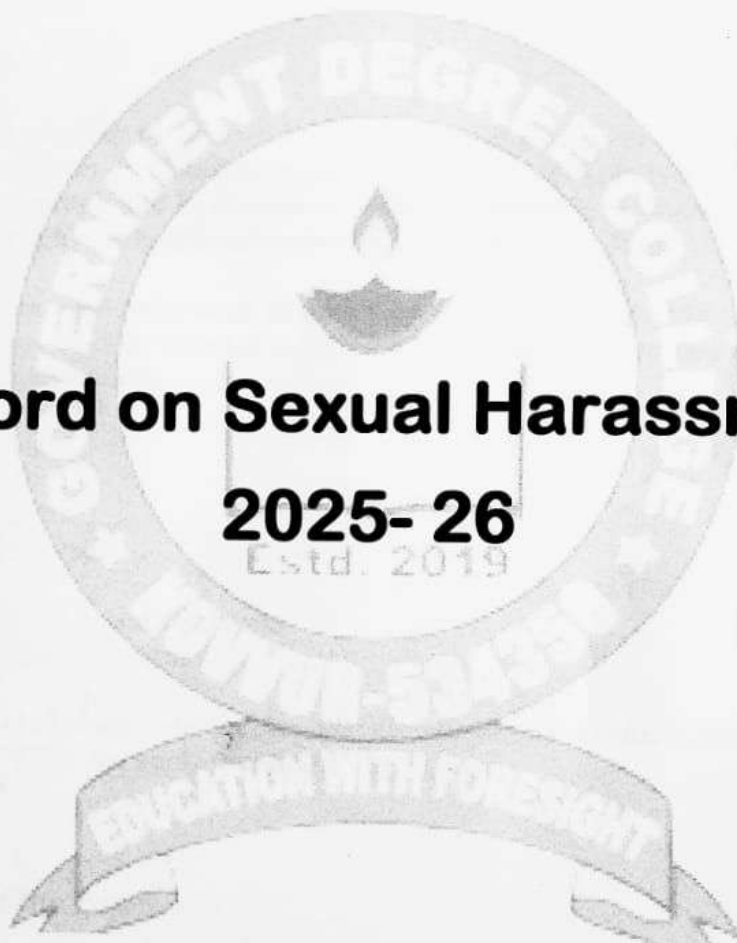

Policy on Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment

1. Introduction

The college strictly follows the provisions of the **Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (POSH Act)** and the **UGC (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2015**.

These regulations are applicable to **all Higher Educational Institutions in India**, including government colleges, and are intended to ensure a safe, secure, and gender-sensitive environment for employees and students.

The policy applies to:

- Teaching staff
- Non-teaching staff
- Students
- Contract / Outsourced employees
- Visitors / Guests / Interns

The definition of workplace under the Act includes **educational institutions**, therefore the provisions of the POSH Act apply to colleges. (POSHequili)

2. Objectives of the Policy

- To prevent sexual harassment at workplace and campus
- To prohibit any form of gender-based discrimination
- To provide a safe environment for women employees and students
- To establish a proper complaint and redressal mechanism
- To ensure awareness about legal provisions
- To promote respect, dignity, and equality in the campus

The UGC Regulations require institutions to ensure a **safe and gender-sensitive environment for women employees and students**. (OGCTA)

3. Definition of Sexual Harassment

Sexual harassment includes any unwelcome act such as:

- Physical contact or advances
- Demand or request for sexual favours
- Sexually coloured remarks
- Showing pornography
- Any verbal, non-verbal, or physical conduct of sexual nature

These definitions are based on the POSH Act and UGC Regulations. (OGCTA)

4. Applicability

This policy applies to:

- All employees (teaching & non-teaching)
- All students (UG / PG / Certificate / Minor courses)
- Any person present on campus
- Activities conducted outside campus (tour, internship, field visit, training, etc.)

UGC Regulations, 2015 extend protection to **employees and students in Higher Educational Institutions.** (iPleaders)

5. Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)

As per the POSH Act, every institution must constitute an **Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)** to handle complaints. (Women and Child Development)

The college shall maintain an ICC with:

- Presiding Officer (Woman faculty)
- Two faculty members
- One non-teaching staff member
- One external member (NGO / Legal / Social worker)

Functions of ICC:

- Receive complaints
- Conduct enquiry
- Recommend action
- Maintain confidentiality
- Submit reports

UGC Regulations also mandate formation of ICC in all colleges. (Nirathanka)

6. Responsibilities of the Institution

The college shall:

- Display POSH policy on notice boards and website
- Conduct awareness programs
- Organize gender sensitization workshops
- Provide complaint mechanism
- Protect complainant from retaliation
- Take disciplinary action if required

Higher Educational Institutions must publicize the POSH Act and UGC Regulations among staff and students. (Ungender)

7. Complaint Procedure

- Complaint must be submitted to ICC
- Inquiry will be conducted confidentially
- Report will be submitted to Principal
- Action will be taken as per rules

Possible actions:

- Warning / apology
- Suspension
- Removal from post
- Cancellation of admission
- Legal action

UGC Regulations provide penalties and disciplinary action for proven cases. (Higher Education Haryana)

8. Awareness and Prevention Measures

The college will conduct:

- Posters / circulars / website information

UGC directs colleges to ensure awareness and training on POSH compliance. (Team Lease RegTech)
