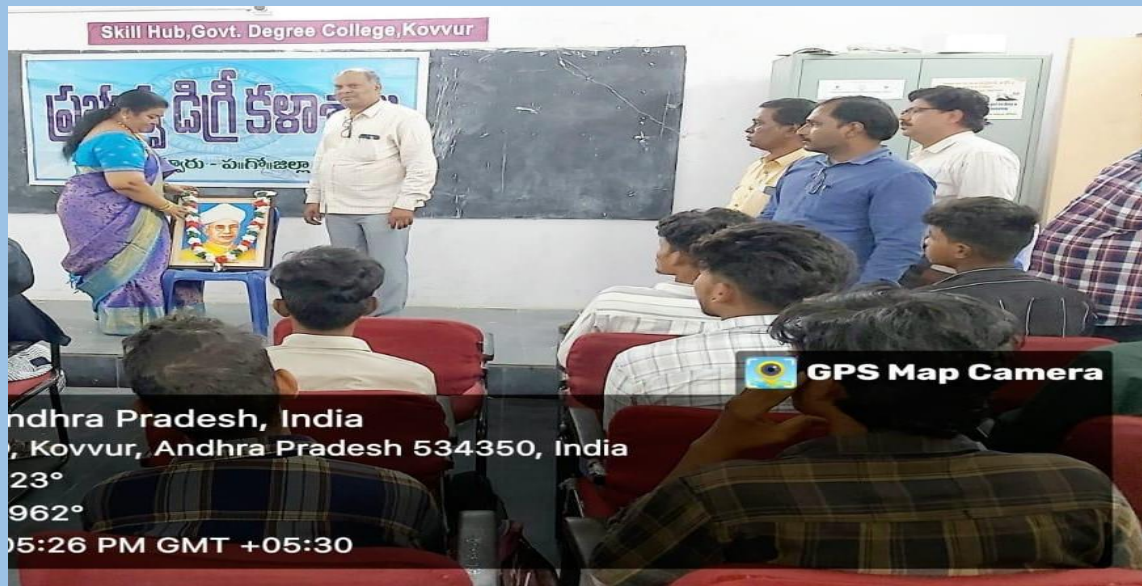

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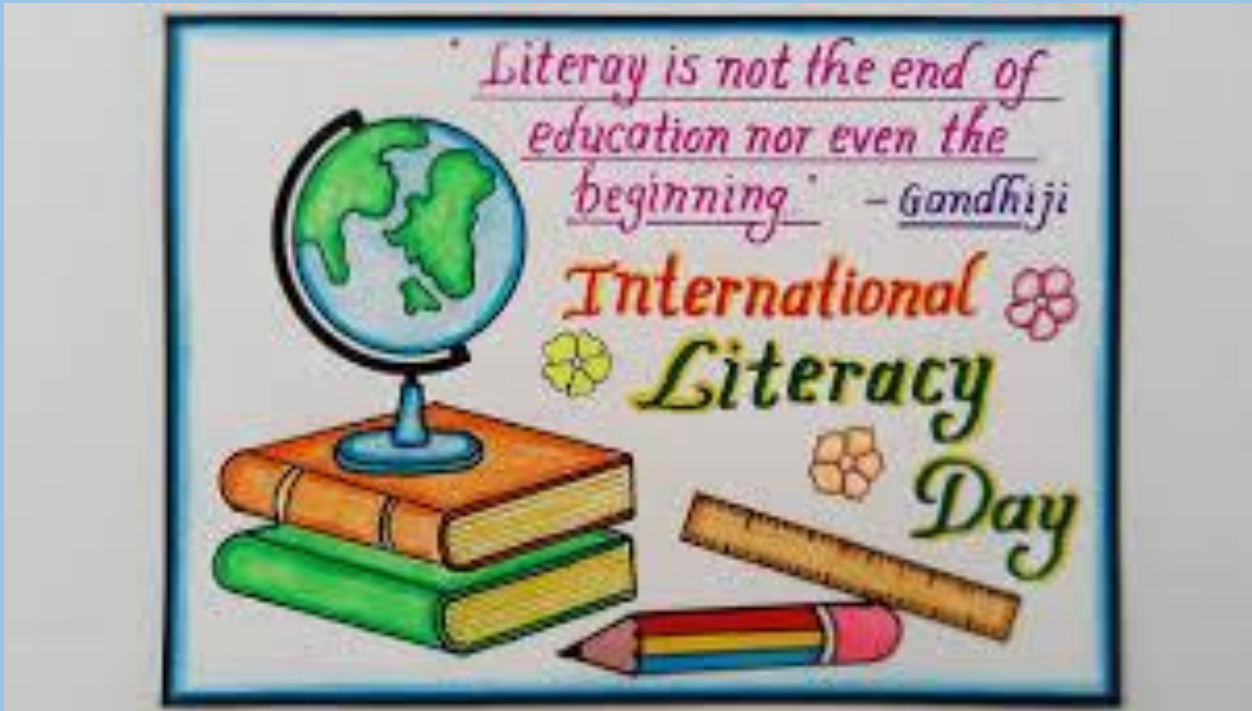
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05-09-2024 Teachers' Day

13-9-2024 Student Induction Programme



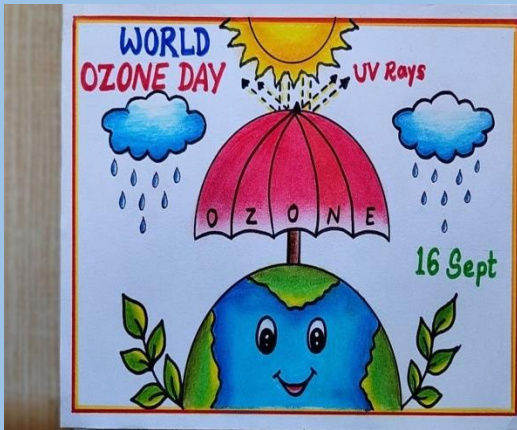
